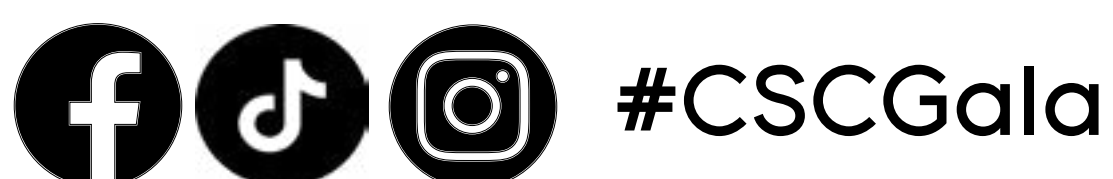

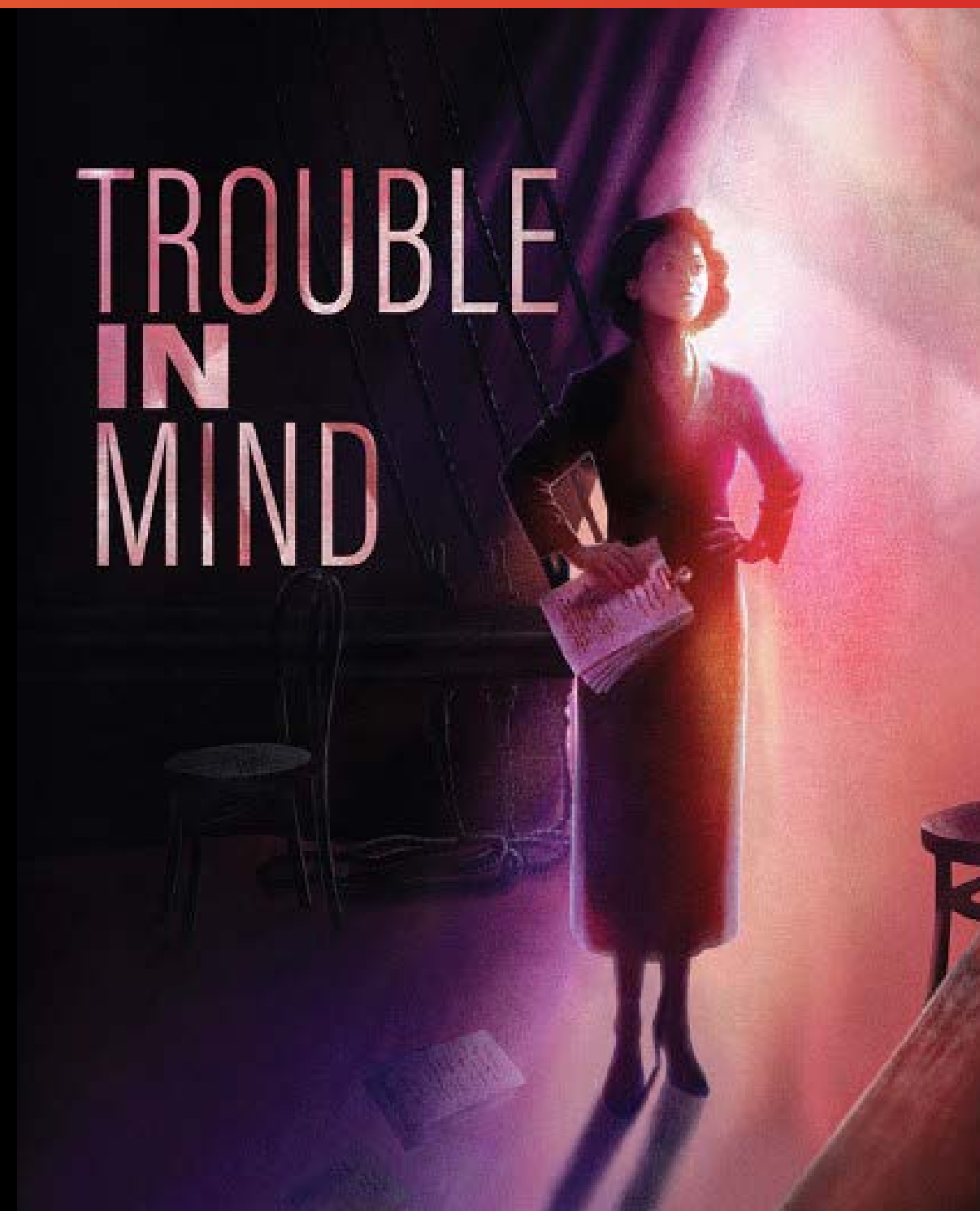

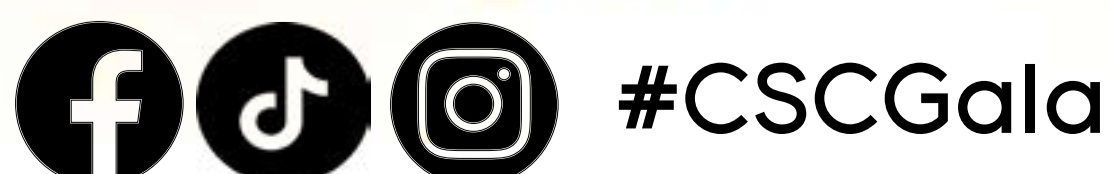

established her independent agency, SLD Associates, in 2019, building on her 35 years of experience and well-earned reputation for advocating and shepherding the careers and artistry of theater artists. She began her career with literary agent Helen Harvey, one-time head of William Morris' Legit Department and, to her good fortune, her mother. Her background includes a brief stint with Jujamcyn Theaters followed by a twenty-year association with legendary agent Flora Roberts. Ms. Douglas assumed ownership and administration of Flora Roberts Inc. following Ms. Roberts' death, representing iconic plays such as *The Diary of Anne Frank* and *The Gin Game*, and works by Alice Childress, Ionesco, Dorothy Parker, Jean Anouilh and Christopher Fry. She is proud to have fulfilled Harry Abrams' wish to expand the theatrical literary department of Abrams Artists Agency, where she had the privilege of working with many of the theater's most talented designers, composers, playwrights, artists, and agents for fifteen years. Currently, her clients include Maury Yeston, Richard Maltby, Jr. & David Shire, Jennifer Tipton, Iris Dart, Mike Stoller, Joyce Carol Oates, Irene Mecchi, Daniel Mate, Sean Hartley and Ashley Tata.



JOHN WEIDMAN

has written the books for a wide variety of musicals, among them *Pacific Overtures*, *Assassins* and *Road Show*, all with scores by Stephen Sondheim; *Contact*, co-created with director/choreographer Susan Stroman; *Happiness*, score by Scott Frankel and Michael Korie, *Take Flight* and *Big*,



scores by Richard Maltby Jr. and David Shire; the new book, co-authored with Timothy Crouse, for the Lincoln Center Theater/Roundabout Theatre/National Theatre revivals of Cole Porter's *Anything Goes*, and *Arrabal*, score by Gustavo Santaolalla, directed and co-choreographed by Sergio Trujillo. He is currently working on a musical adaptation of the movie *Norma Rae* with composer/lyricists Rosanne Cash and John Leventhal and on a revision of the Jerome Weidman/Harold Rome 1962 musical, *I Can Get It for You Wholesale*. When his children were preschoolers, Weidman began writing for "Sesame Street", receiving more than a dozen Emmy Awards for Outstanding Writing for a Children's Program. He is a graduate of Yale Law School and a retired member of the New York State bar. From 1999 to 2009 he served as President of the Dramatists Guild of America.

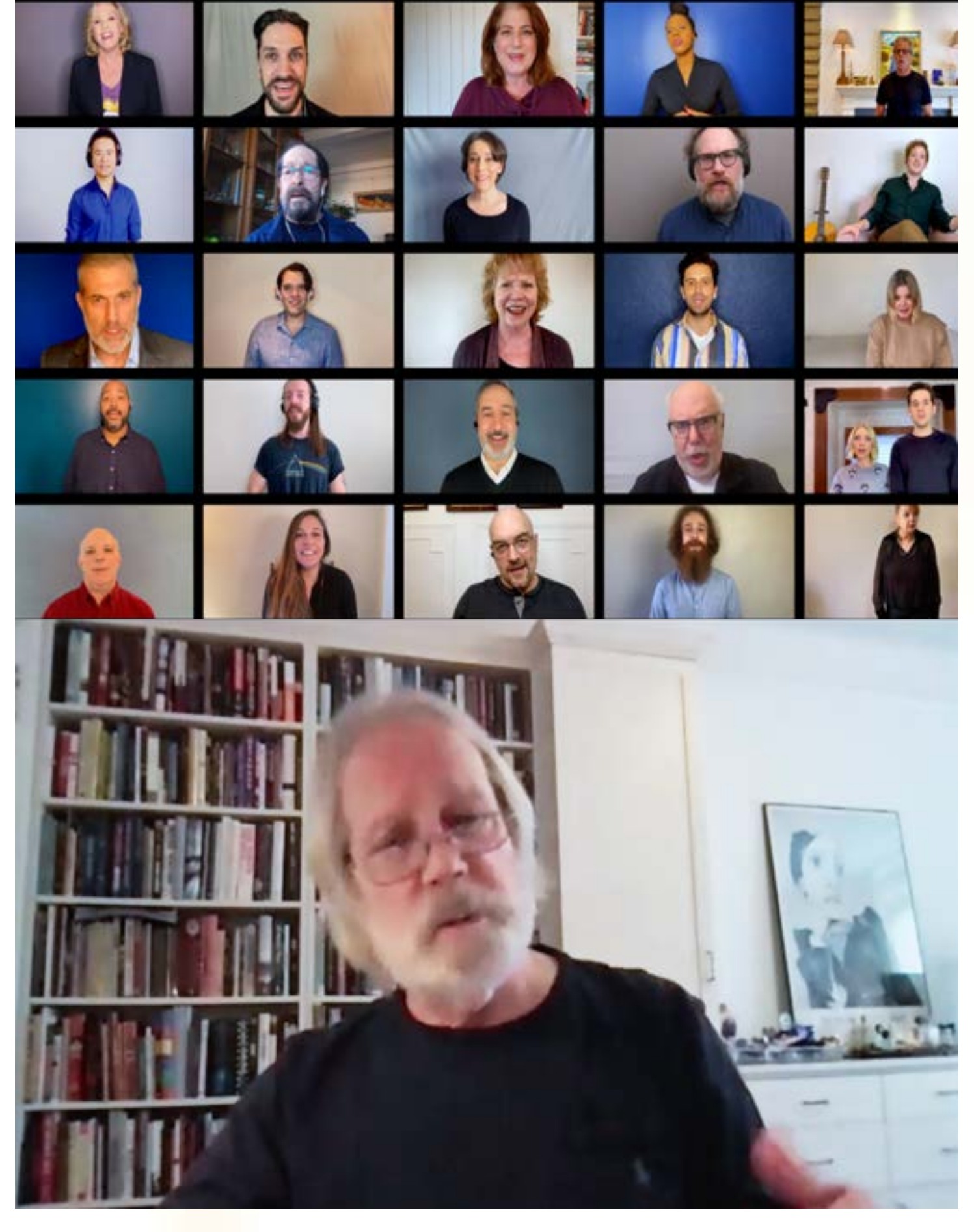

When *Assassins* received a full production at CSC in 2021, the cast included Adam Chanler-Berat, Ethan Slater and Brandon Uranowitz. The production received nominations for 4 Lortel Awards, 3 Drama Desk Awards and 6 Outer Critics Circle Awards, including Outstanding Revival.

SARAH DOUGLAS AND THE LEGACY OF ALICE CHILDRESS

As one of America's most prominent and respected literary agents, Sarah Douglas has a reputation for putting the artist first and for ensuring that her clients' wishes and legacies are prioritized. As the agent for the Alice Childress Estate, Sarah has been a remarkable champion of

Childress, making sure that this remarkable American playwright has the place she deserves in the canon. Childress's plays have been under-produced and often overlooked, despite an influential and culturally significant body of work. Childress herself stood up for her art, refusing to alter the tone or subject matter of her work to make it more commercially acceptable in its day. As a result, Childress never saw her work produced on Broadway in her lifetime, but Sarah has fought to get Childress the stage she deserved, without compromise. In 2021, Childress's *Trouble in Mind*, written in 1955, finally made it to Broadway, starring LaChanze and directed by Charles Randolph-Wright. From this platform, Childress's works are now being produced across America, and CSC is proud to present her landmark *Wine in the Wilderness* in the spring of 2024. This could not have happened without Sarah's incredible advocacy, and we are thrilled to partner with Sarah as we help cement Childress's legacy in the American theatrical canon.

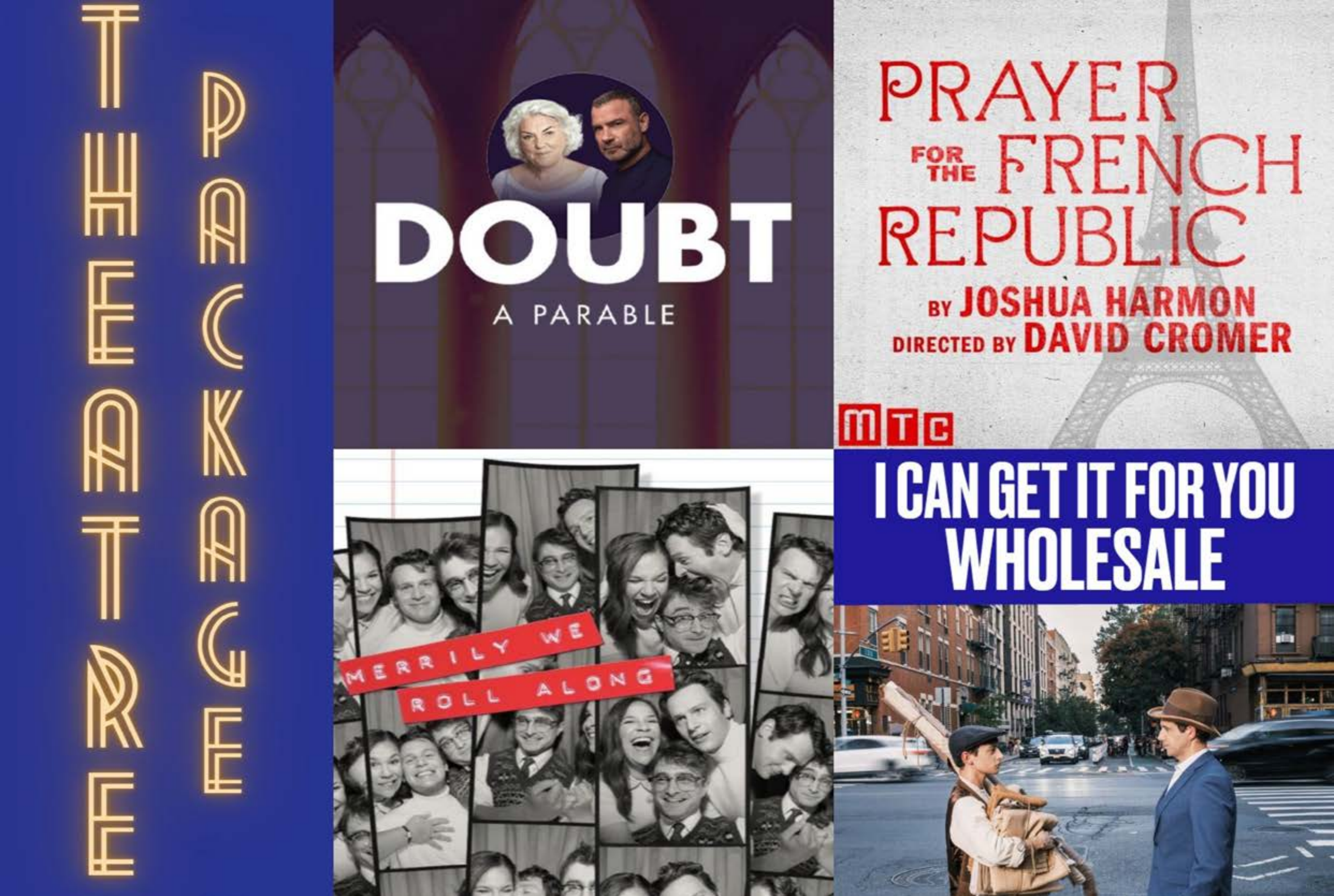
