ABOUT CSC'S EDUCATION PROGRAM

CLASSIC STAGE COMPANY EDUCATION & OUTREACH PROGRAMMING

INSPIRING A LOVE OF THEATER

Education is at the core of CSC's service to the public. Throughout the years, CSC has served over 45,000 students through education programs that provide in-depth training and exposure to all aspects of the theater industry. CSC provides essential artistic experiences to local students that offer them an outlet for creative expression and appreciation for theater.

Our programs include:

AFTER-SCHOOL CLASSICAL THEATER

Middle school students work to command complex texts by supplementing their in-class work on classical texts with an in-depth, multiweek residency culminating in a final presentation at CSC's theater. In recent years, the program explored themes of "honor" and "power" with works by Ana Caro Mallén de Soto, Sor Juana Ines de la Cruz, and William Shakespeare.

ENRICHMENT WORKSHOPS

CSC teaching artists lead rigorous and fun in-school and after-school workshops for middle and high school students. Our workshops give students the opportunity to embody the ideas they are learning about with their classroom teachers.

NEXTGEN

Our free high school program, NextGen, gives students who are considering a career in theater incredible behind-the-scenes access at our Off-Broadway theater. NextGen members meet and participate in workshops with theater professionals to learn hands-on about the many roles in a life in the theater.

PRE-PROFESSIONAL ACTOR TRAINING PROGRAM

Suitable for serious high school students, CSC's pre-professional actor training program prepares young actors for careers in theater, film, and television. CSC is currently partnering with Exploring the Arts on a three-year program with a cohort of high school students from across the five boroughs. Students begin the program as sophomores and graduate as seniors. The curriculum covers archetypes, physical theater, audition technique, voice and breath, scene study, script analysis, genre/style, the industry, and more, done through an intersectional lens that values equity and diversity.

STUDENT MATINEES

Because we value the next generation of theatergoers, CSC presents at least two student matinee performances for every production in our season. Tickets for these performances are highly subsidized and include an inspiring post-performance conversation with artists from the show as well as an in-depth show guide.

Nikki M. James was nominated for her performance as Ida B. Wells in *Suffs*, currently running at the Music Box Theater. She originated the role of Nabalungi in *The Book of Mormon*, for which she won the Tony for Best Featured Actress in a Musical.

Favorite theater credits include Tony Kushner's *A Bright Room Called Day* (Public), Broadway productions of *Les Misérables*, *All Shook Up* and *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer*, *Bubbly Black Girl Sheds Her Chameleon Skin* (Encores!), *Romeo & Juliet*, *Caesar & Cleopatra* alongside Christopher Plummer (Stratford Theater), *The Wiz* (La Jolla Playhouse), *Julius Caesar*, *Twelfth Night* (Shakespeare in the Park), *Bernarda Alba* (Lincoln Center), and *Preludes* (LCT3).

Recent notable work in television includes "Severance" (AppleTV+) and starring roles in "Proven Innocent" for FOX and CBS's quirky series "Braindead." She can be seen in the upcoming Disney+ show "Daredevil."

As a director, Nikki has helmed episodes of "The Bite" and "The Good Fight." She served as an assistant director to Michael Arden for the Broadway revival of *Once On This Island* and *A Christmas Carol* live capture starring Jefferson Mays.

She resides in New York City with her family and holds a BFA in Drama from NYU. She is a proud voter and a sustaining member of her local public radio station. @nikkimjames





HONOREE

Frank DiLella is a seasoned journalist with over two decades of experience covering New York City's vibrant entertainment community. Known for his insightful interviews and comprehensive coverage as the host of "On Stage" on Spectrum News NY1, DiLella has established himself as a prominent voice in New York City's arts and entertainment scene.

Throughout his career, DiLella has conducted interviews with many legendary artists, including Tom Hanks, Vanessa Redgrave, Bono, Nathan Lane, Elton John, Ryan Murphy, Liza Minnelli, Patti LuPone, Bette Midler, Bernadette Peters, Hugh Jackman, Tom Stoppard, Lin-Manuel Miranda, James Earl Jones, Chita Rivera, Alicia Keys, Jane Fonda, Jake Gyllenhaal, Samuel L. Jackson, Jessica Chastain, Angela Lansbury, Judith Light, Kristin Chenoweth, Idina Menzel, Lady Gaga, Tony Kushner, and Andrew Lloyd Webber.

His work has been recognized with numerous awards, including 11 New York Emmy Awards, 8 New York Press Club Awards, and an Edward R. Murrow Award. In 2022, he was honored by the Association of LGBTQ+ Journalists for his Spectrum News Special, "Pride and Perseverance."

Beyond his work at NY1 News, DiLella has contributed to various outlets, including the Tony Awards, the Olivier Awards, Playbill, MANHATTAN Magazine, and Broadway Direct. He regularly appears on MSNBC's "Morning Joe," where he's been affectionately referred to as "the Broadway guy." He has also made appearances on "The Tamron Hall Show," Andy Cohen's "Watch What Happens Live," the AOL BUILD Series, BBC, CBS, NBC, CTV, and has been heard on The Broadway Podcast Network, iHeart Radio, and Sirius XM. In January 2022, DiLella executive produced and hosted the documentary "Reopening: The Broadway Revival," featuring Sara Bareilles, Kristin Chenoweth, Andrew Lloyd Webber, and other notable theater artists. This PBS Great Performances special offered a unique glimpse into the challenges and triumphs of the Broadway industry during the COVID-19 pandemic.

DiLella has also made numerous on-screen appearances, including in Ryan Murphy's "The Prom" opposite Meryl Streep, "Smash," "The Little Voice," "Gossip Girl," and "The Forty-Year-Old Version."

Committed to fostering the next generation of artists, DiLella serves on the selection committee for the annual Clive Barnes Award and Foundation, which honors talented young professionals in dance and theater.

A graduate of Fordham University at Lincoln Center, DiLella returned to his alma mater in 2013 where he currently serves as an adjunct professor - teaching entertainment journalism.



ABOUT CSC

In 1967, director Christopher Martin founded CSC Repertory in a 100-seat theater at Rutgers Presbyterian Church on West 73rd Street. Following short stints in small spaces, CSC grew to the point where it needed a permanent home. In 1973, the theater moved to its present premises on 13th Street, an intimate space that was formerly an East Village carriage house.






